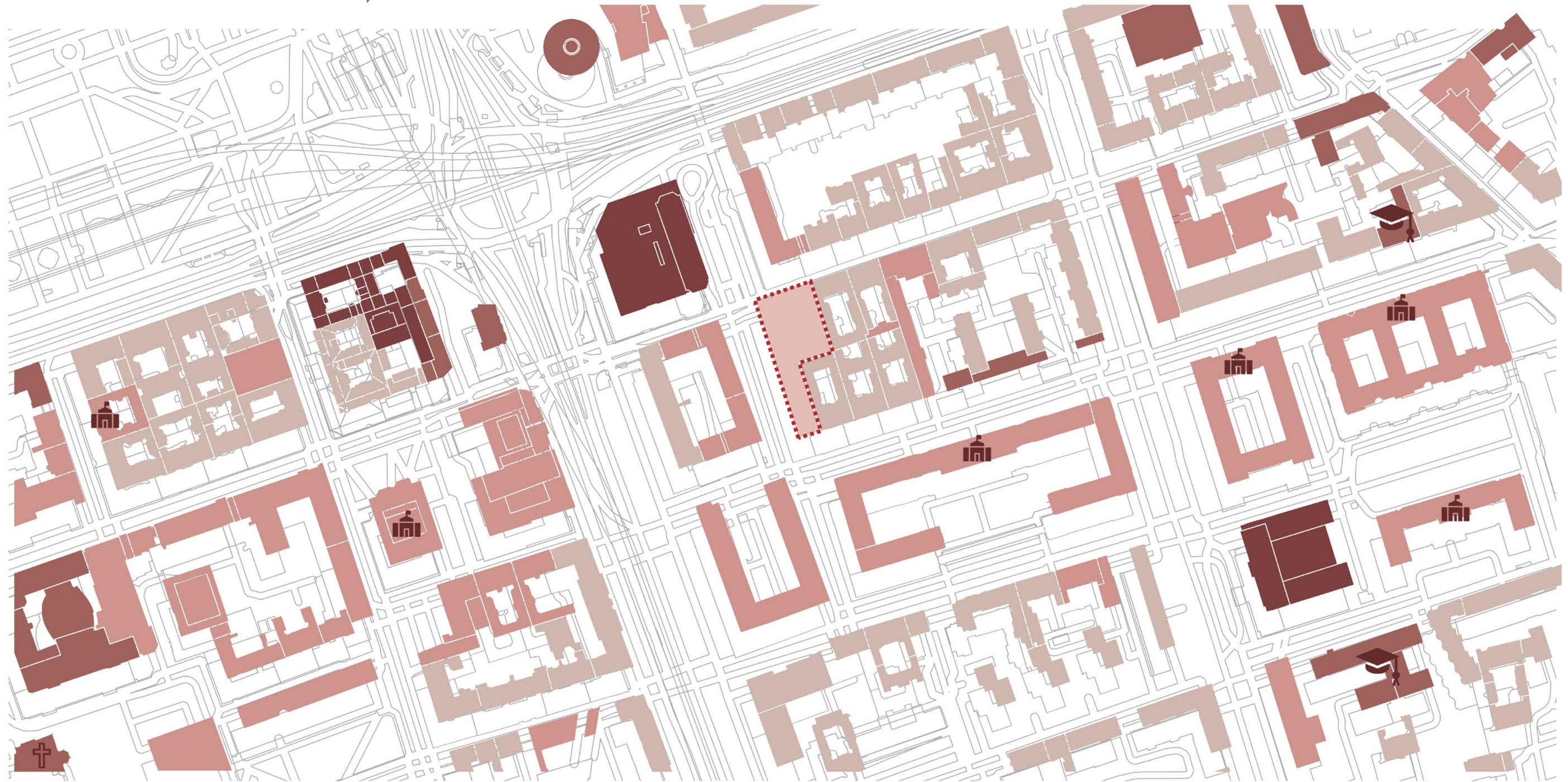


FUNCTIONAL ANALYSIS, scale 1:2000

Parkingowa Street is located in the inner city of Warsaw, an area characterised by high traffic and mixed-use developments. The neighbourhood features a variety of uses, including multifamily housing (primarily mid-rise blocks with historic architecture), different services (such as cafes, restaurants, bakeries, and grocery stores), office spaces, and hotels.

The multi-story garage under analysis is located in one of the most recognisable districts of Warsaw, near the Palace of Culture and Science, the main railway station, and the Zote Tarasy Shopping Centre. In addition, there are numerous cultural facilities nearby, including museums and theatres. The area hosts several educational institutions, such as the Warsaw University of Technology and the Warsaw School of Economics.
