## GREEN SPACES AND BUILDINGS HEIGHT ANALYSIS, scale 1:2000





In the study area, the multifamily housing quarters feature low- and middle-high-growth semi-public greenery, which constitutes the majority of green spaces in the district. This zone includes several tree-lined streets and small parks with public greenery that have withstood the rapid development of this central urban area.

Although the Warsaw city center encounters significant spatial and developmental constraints, it has successfully preserved green areas. However, to address the increasing demands for climate resilience and urban livability, it is crucial to further integrate greenery into the urban landscape.
